COVID Plan Phase 1

Minimal to Moderate Risk with No Positive Cases

*ALL COVID MITIGATION STRATEGIES WERE REMOVED EXCEPT SANITATION PROCEDURES

Classroom:

- Individual student desks will be spaced 4-6 feet apart. -Individual student kits will be available (no shared pencils, etc.) -Small group activities will be allowed with social distancing or mask when social distancing is not possible.
- -Hand sanitizer will be available and used regularly.
- -Touch free timers will be available for use during hand washing.
- -Students with exposure in the home will be asked to wear a mask for 2 weeks.
- -Students will wear masks if they, or their parents, choose it. -Students seen putting their hands in their mouth, nose, or eyes will be asked to sanitize her/his hands.
- -Students' desks will be sanitized daily. Shared areas will be sanitized before being used by another student.
- -Shared items, such as books, will be returned to a dated bin and not reused or put away for 3 days.
- -Teachers will be provided with clear face shields. Face shields or cloth face-covering should be worn when social distancing is not possible.

Playground/Water Fountain:

- -We will double up on staff for more supervision.
- -No masks will be required during physical activity, but social distancing and no-contact play will be encouraged.
- -Equipment will be sanitized weekly.
- -Students will wash hands upon entering the building after recess.

-Students will use water bottles only. No fountain.

Cafeteria:

- -Hands will be washed prior to entering the cafeteria.
- -Students will be socially distanced during lunch and seated by household.
- -Hands will be sanitized after lunch.

Transportation:

- -Students' temperatures will be taken as they enter the bus. Students with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to embark.
- -Seating will be assigned, and students will sit according to their household. -Seating will be appropriately spaced and staggered with as much room between students as possible.
- -Buses seats will be sanitized daily.
- -Disposable masks will be available for use upon parent requests, or when appropriate distancing isn't possible.

Health Protocols:

- -Symptomatic students will be separated, their temperature taken, masked, and parents will be called.
- -Symptomatic staff members will be sent home.
- -Students/Staff who are symptomatic, and/or who are awaiting test results for COVID-19, will be expected to follow the Release from Isolation Guidelines set forth by the AZ Dept of Health Services.
- -Students will be assigned masks that will be labeled and only used by them. Cloth masks will be sanitized regularly at the school. Disposable masks will be discarded at day's end.
- -Commonly touched items (i.e. light switches, door handles, etc.) will be disinfected at least daily.

Arrival of staff/students to building:

- -Temperatures will be taken upon arrival (unless already taken on the bus).
- -All staff and students will be expected to wash hands immediately upon arrival.

Restrooms:

- -Students will be allowed in the restroom one at a time. -Students will wash their hands in the restroom and also sanitize upon arrival back to class.
- -Restrooms will be sanitized daily.
- -Sinks will be sanitized hourly.

Visitors:

- -Guest will be allowed in the entry area only.
- -Temperatures will be taken before entering the building.
- -All visitors will be asked to wear masks.
- -Deliveries will be made to the front porch only.
